STORRS, CT – Emmy and Tony-Award winning actress Kristin Chenoweth promises an eclectic evening of song selections to UConn’s Jorgensen Center for the Performing Arts on Saturday, October 20, including personal reminiscences, Broadway showtunes, and music from her recent album, “The Art of Elegance,” her first album of American Songbook classics from Concord Records.

Kristin Chenoweth won a Tony Award in 1999 for her performance in “You’re a Good Man, Charlie Brown,” and was also nominated for originating the role of Glinda the Good witch in “Wicked” in 2004. In 2009, Chenoweth received an Emmy Award for Best Supporting Actress in a Comedy Series for her role in “Pushing Daisies,” and was nominated for two Emmy Awards and a People’s Choice Award for her role on “Glee.” In 2015, Chenoweth received a coveted star on The Hollywood Walk of Fame. Most recently, she starred in the second season of the NBC sitcom “Trial and Error.”

Chenoweth has performed to sold-out audiences around the world, including performances at Carnegie Hall and Royal Albert Hall. Her album “The Art of Elegance” debuted at #1 on Billboard’s Current Jazz and Traditional Jazz charts, and #1 on Amazon’s Vocal Pop Chart. Her Jorgensen performance, a cabaret event, begins at 8 pm. Doors open at 7 pm.
