Under the baton of music director Jonathan Cohen, Quebec City-based chamber orchestra Les Violons du Roy will be joined on the Jorgensen stage Wednesday evening, October 10<sup>th</sup> by internationally acclaimed countertenor Anthony Roth Costanzo for a captivating evening of music featuring compositions by 18th century baroque composer George Frideric Handel and 20th century contemporary composer Philip Glass. Praised as “vocally brilliant and dramatically fearless” by *The New York Times*, Mr. Costanzo has been electrifying audiences in major concert venues around the world with his powerful, sparkling falsetto tones and passionate delivery since bursting onto the international opera scene in 2012 with his first place award in Placido Domingo’s Operalia Competition. The program begins at 7:30 pm and will be preceded by a Concert Talk at 6:45 pm.
