STORRS, CT – Celebrated for its infectious exuberance, and perennially fresh in its artistry, the **Vienna Piano Trio** has long been hailed as one of the “world’s leading ensembles of piano, violin, and cello” (The Washington Post). These stellar musicians bring their passion and razor-sharp performance skills to **Jorgensen Center for the Performing Arts** on **Saturday, Feb. 22** for a richly diverse program that includes works by Haydn, Ravel and Mendelssohn.

The Trio was founded in 1988 by the Viennese pianist Stefan Mendl. His partners are the Californian violinist David McCarroll, a member of the trio since 2015, and the Austrian cellist Clemens Hagen, who joined in 2018. Together, the players embody the ensemble’s continuing commitment to bridging the traditions and practice of Europe and America.

This performance will begin at **8:00 pm** and will be preceded by a Concert Talk at 7:15 pm by Dr. Heather de Savage, UConn Music Department Adjunct Professor. Doors to the hall will open at 7:30 pm.
